





The CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education) has announced accepting a payment gateway for managing and disbursing various payments over the Integrated Payment System. According to a press release issued by the CBSE, the features of the newly developed IPS are as per the principles of **Ease of Doing Business (EoDB)** and **Ease of Living (EoL)** which are being implemented for the Affiliation Inspection Payment, Board, and CTET exam duty payments.

The newly technology system changed digitally transformed and a less time-consuming into an efficient system deficient from human error. The IPS will enable an automatic calculation payment, to direct bank transfer and TA/DA to the intended payee. The board also allows automatic validation checks which will reduce the time taken to complete the payment process and also reduce the possibility of committing false transactions and non-genuine disbursements.

Our school **Holy Cross School, Pabiacherra, kumarghat**, CBSE affiliation has attend the One hour offline training on IPS held at Darchawi Christian HS School on **13 .01.23** with participation of 10 members from different CBSE affiliated School under Unakoti district. The one hour training had a discussion and explanation about the Integrated Payment System as well as how the IPS system could be effectively used by the CBSE School. The Principal of Darchawi Christian HS School highlighted about the **IPS system** and **why it was introduced by the CBSE Board** . The principal mentioned how the new technology could make the payment transaction with no error and less mistake within a short period of time. The office in charge Mr. Rothlinga Darlong has taken the technical session of **Integrated Payment System (IPS) for payment conduct of Term-II Examinations**. Different units from CBSE Schools under the Unakoti district learnt about the new IPS system, its importance and necessity for all the CBSE Board Examination Center.

Vision on IPS System – Transforming CBSE into a state of the art technology driven, e - governed and digitally empowered educational organization of international repute, having global outreach high responsiveness in the successful functioning of all its domains and making it stake holders friendly (conforming to **Ease of Doing Business (EoDB)** and **Ease of Living (EoL)**).

However, we had a webinar on **31. 01. 2023**. Online Orientation of all Regional Officers, Centers of Excellences, and other Units of the Board on Integrated Payment System. The Online Orientation of Resource Persons on Integrated Payment System (IPS) in CBSE System has a theme and a motto with “Awareness is one of the essential ingredients of developing belief, awareness has been highlighted by many as a keen indicator of success in a range of performance environment”. According to Resource person the awareness programme and Integrated system has designed into two stages. **First stage** is online Orientation of Resource Persons which is being conducted by center of excellences to various district nominated from different consultation with the regional officeses. **Second stage** is physical mode of orientation. In this stage participation of all CBSE affiliated school is mandatory.

The online orientation programme conducted by the Resource Persons from the **Controller of the examination CBSE, Director Training of CBSE (Dr. Ram Shankar)**. He is a man of distinct vision and a fountain head of illuminating ideas knowledgeable, experienced and inspiration to all of us. The second speaker led by **Director of IT CBSE Ministry of Education (Dr. Antriksh Johri)** is a well recognized figure in CBSE IPS system. He is known for IT enthusiasm and high achievements. He has moulded the life of principals, teachers, students and different stakeholders.



Various activity in IPS CBSE system –

- a) Affiliation
- b) Board Exam Center & Functionaries
- c) Practical Exam
- d) Spot Evaluation
- e) Result Committee
- f) Training Resource Person
- g) Competitive Exam

Calculation of the payment will be made automatically by the system .Most of the details will be captured from the information submitted by the schools at the time of conduct of examinations. Payment will be released to individual account.The following features of this system for payment conduct of Term-II Examinations having seven modules:

- a) Fixed remuneration for Examination centers
- b) Account details for the functionaries involved in the examination
- c) Details of the examination functionaries
- d) Centre Accounts details
- e) Freeze payments
- f) Final payment report
- g) Grievances

The IPS has rolls out some of external examiners in various way -

- i) After external practical examiners, the CBSE will also start the integrated payment system for the conduct of Term II examination and evaluation.
- ii) The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has launched an Integrated Payment System (IPS) to release the payment of external examiners involved in the conduct of practicals of Term II examinations.
- iii) As per the CBSE, the benefit of IPS is that payment is made directly into the account of the beneficiary by the board. The CBSE has already released the payment of the Term-I examination using the Integrated Payment System (IPS).
- iv) In Integrated Payment System (IPS), automatic payment is released once data has been submitted correctly and freed.
- v) “As communicated earlier, the Board is launching IPS for payment of External Examiner involved in the conduct of practicals of Term -II Examinations. All the concerned are requested to kindly submit the data in the IPS,” the Board said.

Once the data is correct, the same information may be filled in the IPS. The applicable rates will be automatically filled in. CBSE will start releasing the payment in an automotive mode. After the IPS for Term-II Examinations, the CBSE will start payment for evaluation also.In the current IPS, Module for grievance, an icon is also given to raise the issue, if any, by the schools. For sending the grievance, schools can select the type of grievance, fill the remarks and submit the same. Therefore, I thank our principal, headmistress, school committee and teaching staff including Miss. Sukjai Khriam as a school CBSE coordinator and Sir. Biswajit Sigha CBSE teacher in- charge who have contributed their support and assistant help to motive their experience in CBSE IPS system.

ASSESSMENT/EVALUATION OF THE SESSION 2022-23

Assessment and evaluation are a necessary part of any educational experience. Assessment obtains information on all areas of a child's development and learning. It informs educators about how their students are progressing. The following is a list of the major assessments which have been conducted in our school during the session 2022-23.

Periodic Test- I

PT-I exam of classes Nursery to class-X was conducted from 13th June to 18th June and the result of PT-I was declared on 5th August 2022. On a results day, answer sheets of the students have shown to the parents and the report cards are also distributed to the parents.

Half-Yearly exam (nursery to class- VIII) and Periodic test-II (class- IX & X)

Half-yearly exam of classes Nursery to class- VIII and PT-II exam of classes IX and X was conducted from 19/09/2022 to 29/09/2022 and the result was declared on 29/10/2022. On a result day, the answer sheets of the students have shown to the parents and the report cards are also distributed to the parents.

Periodic Test-II (Nursery to class-VIII) and Periodic Test-III (class-IX & X)

PT-II (Nursery to class –VIII) and PT-III (class IX and X) were conducted from 12/12/2022 to 17/12/2022 and the result was declared on 21/01/2023. On the result day, the answer sheets of the students have shown to the parents and the report cards are also distributed to the parents.

Pre-Board exam (Class-X)

One Pre-Board was conducted from 16/01/2023 to 29/01/2023 for class- X and the result were declared on 04/02/2023. On the result day, the answer sheets of the students have shown to the parents and the report cards are also distributed to the parents. After the result of the pre-board exam admit cards for the board final exam were distributed to the students.

Annual exam (Nursery to class-IX)

The annual exam of the nursery to class IX was conducted from 24/02/2023 to 10/02/2023.

The exam committee along with the principal and headmistress prepares guidelines for teachers to prepare question papers for PT-I, PT-II PT-III, and Pre-board exams. Holy Cross Education Foundation (HCEF) prepares half-yearly and annual exam question papers. HCEF prepares half-yearly and annual exam timetables whereas timetables for other exams are prepared by the exam committee, principal, and headmistress. The exam committee prepares proper seating arrangements for the students for different exams. Headmistress along with the exam committee prepares the examination duty chart for the teachers. The committee keeps a record of all the exams held in the school in soft as well as hard copies.
